Jewel A Vignas Community Service Award Application

The \$500 cash grant award is given to one Warwick High School graduating female who has freely given her time and talents in volunteering to at least one non-profit or community service organization in the Lititz/Warwick area. This does not include the mandated Senior Project.

The recipient will be looking to advancing her education in a post-secondary program. This includes Technical, Vocational, Associate or Bachelor degree programs. The recipient will be announced during the Awards assembly.

Method of Selection

Applications may be obtained by interested Warwick students from the high school guidance office. The Vignas family and a designated representative from the Lititz Woman's Club will review the applications without knowledge of the candidates identity and make the final choice of the recipient. All information will be kept confidential. The criteria and determining factors that are considered for choosing a recipient are listed on the application. The award is not based on financial need but on the merits of volunteer work done in the community during the applicant's high school years.
