


Committee Reports

Last year we provided for 105 children. One of our major Christmas Project expenses is BACKPACKS. We purchase them for each school-age child (K-12) on our list. Child Reach is asking every club member who can help us to BUY A BACKPACK and bring it to the October club meeting. Backpacks may also be dropped off to Shirley Flickinger (School
